



Gathering and Cataloging:

Roy was born in Bengali religious reformer, often referred to as "Father of Modern India." Roy was born into a Kulin Brahmin family of civil servants in Bengal. He received a traditional education focused on the study of languages; he was first sent to a religious school in Patna



then went to Banares to study Sanskrit, philosophy, religion, and rhetoric. At the age of 15, Roy traveled to Tibet to study Buddhism. He began to entertain religious
